# Love in Action, Rescue Mission

On February 14, 2026, Valentine’s Day, True Worshippers Kingdom Ministries (TWKM) gathered at Woodruff Park in Atlanta, Georgia, for our “Love in Action” outreach event. With hearts full of compassion and a mission to serve, our team distributed clothing to the unhoused community and prepared more than 100 sandwiches, along with snacks, to help meet immediate needs.

While this act of service was impactful, what we experienced that day was nothing short of miraculous.

As our team was preparing to conclude the outreach, a stranger named LA Michael, whom we now affectionately call “Angel Michael,” approached us asking for prayer for his friend. In a truly divine moment, he shared that he had heard someone faintly calling his name, only to discover it was Greg, a long-lost friend he had not seen in more than 20 years.

Without hesitation, one of our dedicated team members, Savannah, went ahead to locate Greg, an unhoused man lying on the concrete. He had suffered a stroke and had been left helpless, sleeping under a tree for days without proper medical care. His condition was heartbreaking and immediately brought to mind the biblical parable of the Good Samaritan, where a wounded man was left abandoned until someone chose compassion.

When the rest of the team arrived, we found Savannah sitting on the ground beside Greg, reading scripture and speaking words of hope and life into his spirit. Minister Larry also went down to Greg’s level, while the rest of the team joined together, surrounding him in prayer.

Sometimes in life, we reach the end of our rope, but even then, God never leaves us.

Although rain had been forecasted for later that evening, it arrived earlier than expected, almost as if heaven itself was preparing the atmosphere for what God was about to do.

And then, God moved... it started raining.

Greg was gently lifted and placed into one of our vehicles, along with another unhoused gentleman who was also blessed through this divine encounter. TWKM provided three nights at a motel for both men, offering them safety, rest, and dignity.

At the conclusion of their stay, Greg was transported to the hospital, where he finally received the urgent medical care he so desperately needed. A social worker was assigned to his case, and he was later placed into a rehabilitation and living facility.

In an incredible revelation, we later discovered that Greg is a veteran who served ten years in the United States Army, making him eligible for benefits and care that had previously gone unclaimed.

What a mighty God we serve.

Today, both Greg and LA Michael are part of the TWKM family and regularly attend our House-to- House Worship Gatherings. It has been a tremendous blessing to continue pouring into their lives and to minister at the rehabilitation facility, where we are now honored to serve many of the residents as part of our ongoing outreach assignment.

This experience deeply encouraged and humbled us. It reminded us that our calling extends far beyond simply meeting physical needs. It is about being vessels of God’s love, compassion, restoration, and divine intervention.

As disciples of Christ, we are called to go forth, share the message of salvation, and extend a helping hand to those in need, just as Jesus did.

That day, it truly felt as though God Himself stepped in to rescue Greg.

To Greg, thank you for your service. Because of your sacrifice and your relationship with God, He heard your cry and sent this ministry as a vessel to meet your need.

All glory belongs to God.

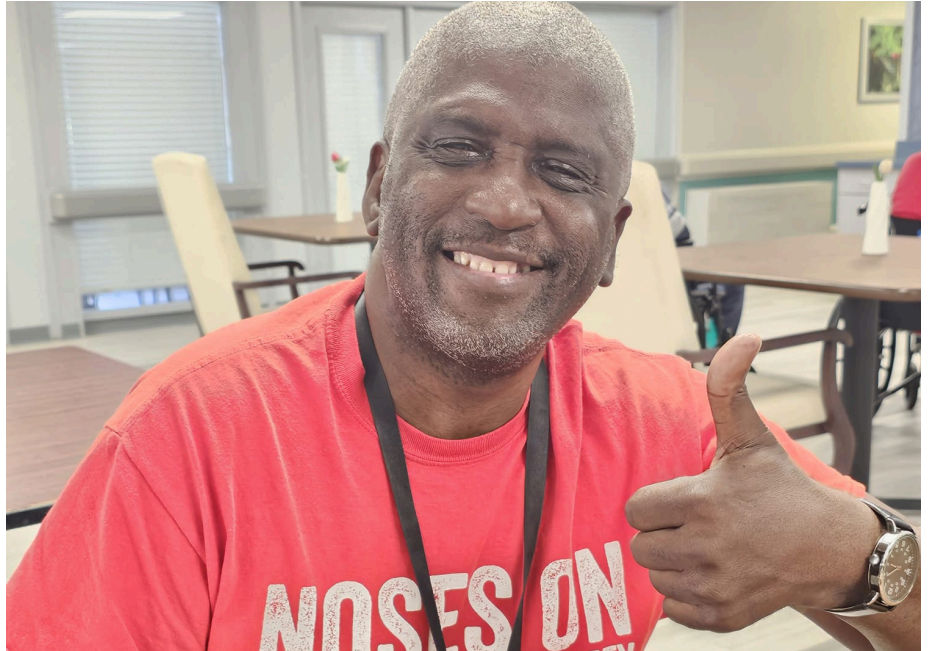
It is an honor to minister to the residents at Orchard at Brookhaven, as well as our newest outreach assignment at Fulton Center for Rehabilitation.

# Kingdom Partner Highlight: Unshakeable Worship in Motion



## Highlights from the Unshakeable Movement Arts Conference

A powerful weekend of storytelling, movement worship, flags, mindfulness, and mime, rooted in the unshakable kingdom within.

The Unshakeable Movement Arts Conference gathered worshippers, artists, and ministry leaders for a powerful weekend centered on one powerful theme: worship that remains steady in heart, mind, and body, no matter the circumstance. Through interactive workshops and hands-on activations, participants explored how testimony, dance, flags, breath-work, and mime can become Spirit-led expressions of praise.

### Morning Glory: Exhortation, Prayer, and Consecration

Presented By: Lea Philippe-Huffman and Kaliah Henton Jones

The conference opened with a powerful exhortation by Lea Philippe-Huffman entitled, “Unshakeable: Deep Roots, Steady Faith, Entering the Holy of Holies,” followed by a sacred time of prayer and consecration unto the Lord, led by Kaliah Henton Jones.

This meaningful moment helped establish the spiritual atmosphere for the weekend ahead, inviting attendees into a posture of worship, surrender, and expectancy as they prepared for a transformative time in God’s presence.

### Writing in the Spirit (Storytelling)

Facilitator: Kaliah Henton-Jones

In “Writing in the Spirit,” Kaliah Henton-Jones encouraged attendees to view personal testimony as more than a memory, but as a living instrument of worship. The session focused on discovering the power of one’s story, learning practical ways to write and share with confidence, and embracing authenticity as an act of worship.

**Key takeaway:** Your story matters, and when shared with honesty and love, it has the power to connect people, strengthen faith, and point others back to God.



## The Unshakeable Kingdom Within: Interpretive/Liturgical Movement

Facilitator: Donna Neu

Donna Neu centered this workshop on a transformative truth: the living, unshakable kingdom of God is within us (Hebrews 12:28; Luke 17:21). From that foundation, attendees explored what it means to worship as embodied temples of the Holy Spirit, allowing the body to participate fully in praise through dance and movement and expressing unity with God and with one another.

The emphasis was freedom: there are no fixed rules for how movement worship must look. Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom, and God’s creativity can be displayed through each worshipper. The workshop invited participants to practice expressing “on earth as it is in heaven,” allowing movement to reflect the splendor of God’s unshakable love and glory.

## Kingdom Partner Highlight (continued)



### **Faith Over Fear: The Unshakeable Worshipper Flags & Billows**

Facilitators: Julie West and Richard Schmitt

In this dynamic flags-and-billows workshop, Julie West and Richard Schmitt guided worshippers into a practical, scripture-rooted understanding of prophetic movement, centered on choosing faith over fear.

The session opened with testimony and encouragement, reminding participants that perseverance itself is an act of worship.

The workshop concluded with a hands-on, Spirit-led worship experience where participants transitioned from instruction into embodied worship through movement and praise.

### **Mindfulness and Breathing Exercises**

Facilitator: Shelemiah Fleming

The morning session featured a guided 20-minute mindfulness and breath-work experience designed to help participants center themselves, reduce stress, and prepare mentally for physical activity. Deep breathing and gentle awareness practices created an atmosphere of intentionality and focus.

The afternoon session emphasized mobility and flexibility through dynamic stretches and movement patterns designed to improve range of motion and prevent injury.

Each session concluded with gentle stretching and restorative breath-work, helping participants release tension, restore calm, and end with a sense of peace and renewal.

### **Unshakeable Worship (Mime)**

Facilitator: Ronald Marshall

Ronald Marshall led participants through the heart of mime ministry, demonstrating how movement, gesture, and emotion can communicate spiritual truths when words are not the primary vehicle.

The workshop emphasized that movement arts can carry profound meaning, helping both worshippers and audiences engage their faith with their whole being.

### **Moments from the Conference: Testimony in Real Time**

Friday night's community worship became a gathering point, an open invitation for attendees to encounter God together through sound, movement, spontaneous praise, and unity.

Many participants expressed gratitude to conference hosts Sharon Hill and Ronald Marshall for creating a space where worshippers could learn, practice, and minister with excellence.

One attendee reflected on a captured moment of dancing during the song "Yeshua," describing it as a reminder that there is truly none like Jesus, and that His fire meets us even when no visible flame is present.

Another testimony celebrated unshakeable faith over fear, reflecting on God's breath, His Ruach, surrounding, refreshing, reviving, and renewing His people in every kind of moment, whether loud or quiet, triumphant or tender.

Beyond the scheduled workshops, the atmosphere itself carried the message. Worship throughout the weekend was powerful, inspiring, and deeply participatory.

### **Closing: Becoming Unshakeable**

Unshakeable worship is not limited to one art form. It is a way of life that remains steady through every season.

Whether through written testimony, interpretive movement, prophetic flags, mindful breathing, or the wordless expression of mime, the conference emphasized one shared invitation: offer God your whole self and allow the Holy Spirit to lead the expression.

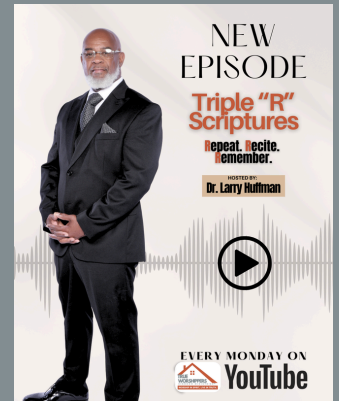
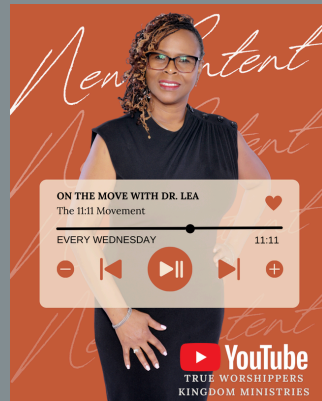
